



Acorns Children's Hospice provides care, support, fun and laughter for life limited and life threatened babies, children and young people and support for their families.

We provide care in our three hospices in Birmingham, the Black Country and the Three Counties, as well as in the family home and community.

Our hospices provide a home from home environment where children can take part in a variety of fun and therapeutic activities, from arts and crafts sessions to hydrotherapy. Children visit Acorns for short breaks, end of life and emergency care, whilst providing families with a much needed break from caring round the clock.

We understand that family time is precious when a child's life is limited, and we support families in any way we can to create lasting memories.

Acorns is here to help families feel equipped to cope at every stage of their child's life with our dedicated team offering psychological, emotional and practical support.

In the past year we have cared for over 700 children and 940 families, including those who are bereaved*. It costs around £10 million* every year to provide our services and we rely on the generosity of the public for the majority of this amount.
